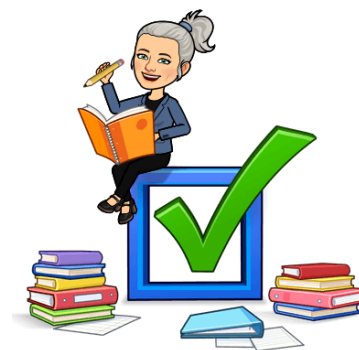


# Mrs Simpson's Sizzling Spotlight

This week's sizzling spotlight is all about our 2022 Student Progress Reporting

Clear and timely reporting of your children's achievements and progress at school is very important. Here at Mareeba SS, your child's teacher will keep you updated of their progress during the year in a number of ways:

- parent-teacher interviews held in week 10, Term 1 & 3
- contacting you directly by telephone
- writing comments in student daily diaries
- student progress reporting formally emailed home in week 10, Term 2 & 4



Student progress reports are a formal report card emailed to families with information about your child/rens academic achievements as well as behaviour and effort. Your child/rens teachers also adds comments about their strengths and areas for improvements as well as a request for a parent interview if necessary.

Reporting for Semester 1, 2022 is still reflective of the Australian Curriculum but will look a little different for some year levels. This year, as in previous years, all students Prep – Year 6 will be reported on **English, Math, Science and HASS**.

In 2022, our Specialist areas (HPE, Technology, The Arts & LOTE) will be reported on over banded years. This is to reflect the Australian Curriculum which provides teachers with Achievement Standards for bands (groups of year levels), rather than for each year. The current Australian Curriculum bands are Prep-Year 2; Years 3-4; Years 5-6.

Below is a table highlighting what learning areas will be reported on for each year level this Semester:

	Green means students have been taught and assessed on that Learning Ares this semester.				
	Not green indicates students have participated in weekly lessons but have not been assessed. This means students have learnt and practices the skills in preparation for assessment in a different Semester.

As an example, a student in Year 6 report card will have an achievement level, effort level and comment for English, Maths, Science, HASS, HPE and LOTE. Their report card will **NOT** have an achievement level, effort level and comment for Technology and The Arts.
