

Sizzling Spotlights from Mrs Simpson

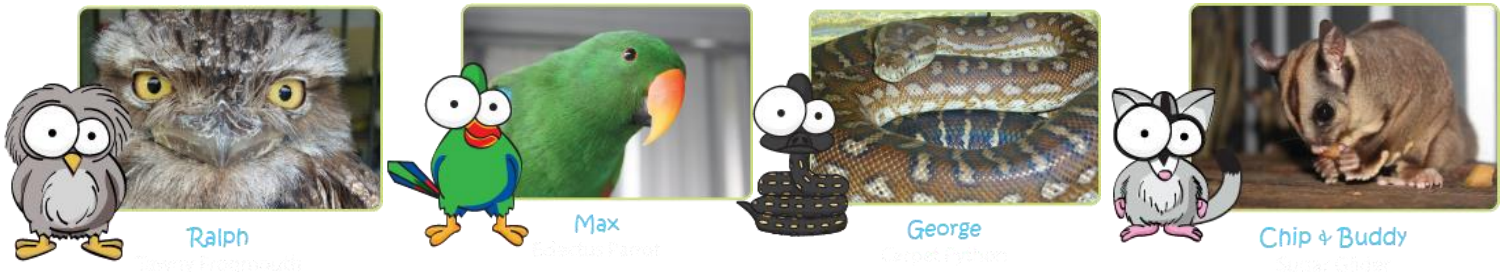
This week's sizzling spotlight is all about our **Zoo to You** visits. Throughout the Australian Curriculum, many students learn about animals whether it be writing an information report, learning about the life cycle of animals or through environmental impacts on an animal's habitat. A resource used by many year levels is the Zoo to You program – an up-close wildlife experience.



The Zoo to You team delivers educational wildlife talks in person in our classrooms giving our learners a 'real life, hands-on' learning experience. When the team visits, led by the owner and founder Jodie Creek, a qualified Teacher and Wildlife Biologist, they bring with them a wide variety of animals for the students to learn about and even hold. These animals range from mammals, marine creatures, birds, reptiles and insects with the favourite of these the Freshwater Crocodile!

Sessions begin with a talk about the animals on a range of topics and are followed with an interactive, hands-on experience in a safe and controlled manner. These sessions also come with resources, teacher notes and student worksheets for follow up activities.
