ESSENTIAL LEARNING ITEMS

2 boxes	Colouring pencils – box 12 or 24 (long) – no felt pens
1 set	Generic Crayons
4	Copy paper - 80 gsm white A4 ream/500
4	Erasers – soft white pencil - no novelty erasers
8	A4 Exercise books – 48 pages – Year 1 ruling
8	Glue Sticks 40gram LARGE
1	Pencil case - large
2	Pencil sharpeners with case/holding container
2 box (12)	Pencils – HB - Staedtler or Esselte (or any good quality) - no erasers on ends of pencils - no clutch pencils. Box stored in classroom – use as needed
2	Plastic wallets with hook and loop fastening system
1	Ruler – 30cm wooden (No Hole)
1	Scissors – medium metal (15cm)
10	Scrapbooks
10	Red colouring pencils - compulsory for bookwork
3 packs of 4	Whiteboard pens
1	Manilla Folders
1	Clean old sock or sponge to use as a whiteboard eraser
1 set	Over ear headphones – NO ear bud headphones – in named ziplock bag
1	Library bag – boldly labelled with child's name. 40cm x 40cm (not drawstring) Available from the Uniform Shop
4	Tissues – large boxes

STUDENTS ALSO REQUIRE:

Most of the following items are available from the Uniform Shop. Please name all items.

- **A suitable hat** – Broad brim (7-8 cm) hat for skin protection. Caps are not suitable. Bucket hats are sold at the Uniform Shop. **'No hat, no play'**
- **Shoes** – Closed-in footwear and socks are required for the protection of students feet from injury and must be worn every day – **'No shoes, no play'**
- **Lunch box** – All students have access to a fridge for their lunch boxes.
- **School uniform** – The wearing of a school uniform is promoted to enhance the child's self image and sense of identity within our school community.
- **'Sun safe'** shirts must be worn for swimming – SPF 50+ rashie swim shirts available in school colours
- **Water bottle** - Each student requires their own labelled drink bottle
- **Medium/Large size school bag/backpack** to keep all belongings together
