## 2021 Requirements List – Year 2

### ESSENTIAL LEARNING ITEMS

QUANTITY	DESCRIPTION
2 boxes	<b>Colouring pencils</b> – box of 12 or 24 (long) - no felt pens
2 boxes of 12	<b>Pencils</b> – HB - Staedtler or Esselte (or any good quality) – no erasers on ends of pencils – no clutch pencils. Box stored in classroom – use as needed
12	<b>Red colouring pencils</b> – compulsory for bookwork
1	<b>Pencil Case</b> – small – to fit in desk
2	<b>Pencil sharpeners</b> – with containers attached
4	<b>Highlighter pens</b>
12	<b>Whiteboard pens</b> (thick) – x1 black
6	<b>Erasers</b> – soft white pencil – no novelty erasers
6	<b>Glue sticks</b> – 35gm
2	<b>Rulers</b> – 30 cm wooden (cm/mm)
1	<b>Scissors</b> – medium 15cm metal pointed (left handed scissors are available)
8	<b>A4 Exercise books</b> – 48 pages – <b>Year 2</b> ruling
3	<b>Quad books</b> -1 cm square ruled – 48 pages A4
6	<b>Scrapbooks</b>
4	<b>Copy paper</b> - 80 gsm white A4 ream/500 ( <i>requirement</i> )
1	<b>Manilla folder</b> – plain unmarked
2	<b>Velcro homework folders</b>
2	Clean old socks to use as a whiteboard eraser
1	<b>Headphones</b> (not earphones) in named ziplock bag
1	<b>Library bag</b> – boldly labelled with child's name. 40cm x 40cm (not drawstring) Available from the Uniform Shop
4	<b>Tissues</b> – large boxes

### STUDENTS ALSO REQUIRE:

Most of the following items are available from the Uniform Shop. Please name all items.

- **A suitable hat** – Broad brim (7-8 cm) hat for skin protection. Caps are not suitable. Bucket hats are sold at the Uniform Shop. **'No hat, no play'**
- **Shoes** – Closed-in footwear and socks are required for the protection of students feet from injury and must be worn every day – **'No shoes, no play'**
- **Lunch box** – All students have access to a fridge for their lunch box. Padded insulated bags remain with student's backpack.
- **School uniform** – The wearing of a school uniform is promoted to enhance the child's self image and sense of identity within our school community.
- **'Sun safe'** shirts must be worn for swimming – SPF 50+ Sun safe rashie swim shirts available in school colours with logo
- **Water bottle** - Each student requires their own drink bottle
- **Medium size school bag/backpack** to keep all belongings together
