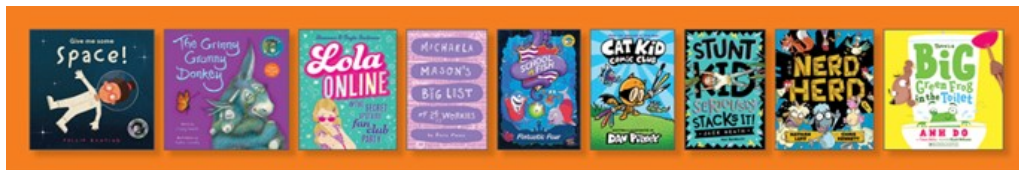
This week's Sizzling Spotlight is all about Book Fair.
