Annually through our student leaders process our Year 5 students have the opportunity to nominate for an Indigenous Leader or Indigenous Ambassador position, a position they will hold for the entire Year 6 school year. Any student who is successful in securing one of these positions will be provided the opportunity to join the ILF program.

As part of the program, our ILF participants will participate in a number of activities including a cultural camp, projects and sharing for success days. At Mareeba SS our students are supported by Ms Fallon Patolo and Ms Bianca Rainbow who assist the students with their projects, attend the cultural camp and regularly check-in with our leaders.
