These boys spend their school holidays travelling with the Moriarty team interstate to train and play with other Moriarty foundation players. For all of our students, having the opportunity to play soccer and build new skills has seen an increase in student attendance and sports.

Moriarty soccer is available for all students in Year 3-6 on the oval, first break, Wednesday and Friday. Each term the year levels participating in Moriarty change to ensure the school has the chance to participate. This term, the focus is on our Year 3 cohort with other students in Years 4-6 also having some Moriarty sessions.
