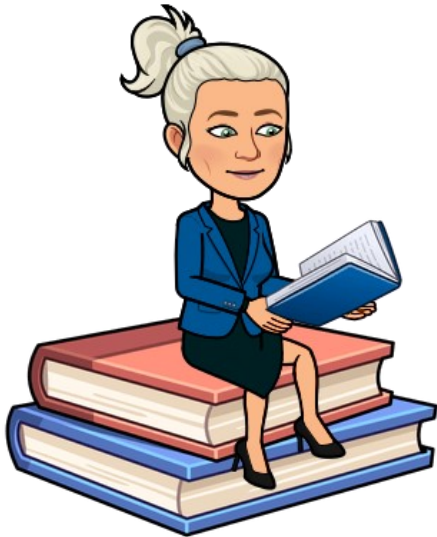
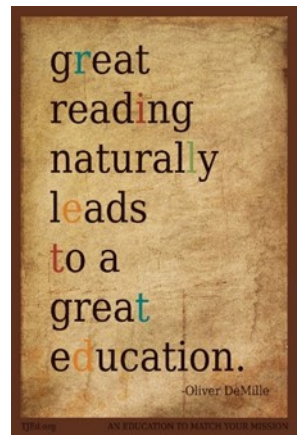


Mrs Simpson's Sizzling Spotlight

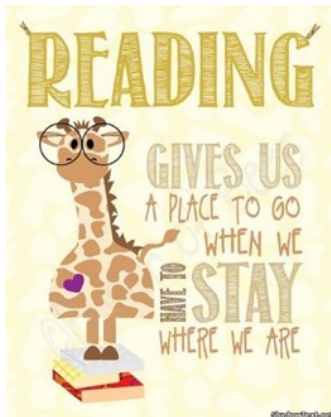
Reading Cafe
