Our student leadership program is based on the following beliefs:

- Leaders provide an active and supportive role in student decision making
- Leaders provide a role model for all students
- Leaders represent the school on required occasions
- Leaders assist other students to be the best they can
- Our staff recognises the positive role students play in the development of a supportive school environment
- Leaders promotes the needs and interests of students

How we determine our student leaders:

- Students in Year 5 submit a written application
- Nominated students for school captain positions make a speech at Parade
- Students in Years 3 / 4 / 5 / staff vote straight after student speeches
- Auslan students will only vote for the Auslan Captain; Instrumental Music students will only vote for the Instrumental Music Captain
