STUDENTS ALSO REQUIRE:

Most of the following items are available from the Uniform Shop. Please name all items.

- A suitable hat Broad brim (7-8 cm) hat for skin protection. Caps are not suitable. Bucket hats are sold at the Uniform Shop. 'No hat, no play'. Clearly labelled.
- Shoes Closed-in footwear and socks are required for the protection of students feet from injury and must be worn every day - 'No shoes, no play'.
- Lunch box (NOT eskys due to limited fridge space) All students have access to a fridge for their lunch boxes.
- School uniform The wearing of a school uniform is promoted to enhance the child's self-image and sense of identity within our school community.
- 'Sun safe' shirts must be worn for swimming SPF 50+ rashie shirts available in school colours with logo
- Water bottle Each student requires their own labelled drink bottle
- Large size school bag/backpack to keep all belongings together
