### STUDENTS ALSO REQUIRE:

Most of the following items are available from the Uniform Shop. Please name all items.

- **A suitable hat** – Broad brim (7-8 cm) hat for skin protection. Caps are not suitable. Bucket hats are sold at the Uniform Shop. **'No hat, no play'. Clearly labelled.**
- **Shoes** – Closed-in footwear and socks are required for the protection of students feet from injury and must be worn every day – **'No shoes, no play'.**
- **Lunch box (NOT eskys due to limited fridge space)** – All students have access to a fridge for their lunch boxes.
- **School uniform** – The wearing of a school uniform is promoted to enhance the child's self-image and sense of identity within our school community.
