



## 2021 Requirements List – Prep

Prep is a very important time for your child. To make this introduction to school as happy and successful as possible we ask you, as parents, to assist in the following ways:

- Ensure all items are clearly named bag, lunch box, hat, shoes, library bag, clothing
- Discuss with your child the need to take care of, and be responsible for, his/her belongings
- Provide a spare set of clothes (including underwear) in a named plastic snap lock bag to keep in their bag

Please cover all books and name all items i.e. each pen/pencil/glue etc. – not just the box. Check at the beginning of each term and replace if necessary. Teachers will send reminders home as required. Learning items are individual and not shared.

## **STUDENTS ALSO REQUIRE:**

Most of the following items are available from the Uniform Shop. Please name all items.

- A suitable hat Broad brim (7-8 cm) hat for skin protection. Caps are not suitable. Bucket hats are sold at the Uniform Shop. 'No hat, no play'. <u>Clearly Labelled.</u>
- **Shoes** Closed-in footwear and socks are required for the protection of students feet from injury and must be worn every day 'No shoes, no play'.
- Lunch box (NOT eskys due to limited fridge space) All students have access to a fridge for their lunch boxes.
- School uniform The wearing of a school uniform is promoted to enhance the child's self image and sense of
  identity within our school community.
- 'Sun safe' shirts must be worn for swimming SPF 50+ rashie shirts available in school colours with logo
- Water bottle Each student requires their own labelled drink bottle
- Large size school bag/backpack to keep all belongings together
