A vital component of the HUB is student wellbeing and welfare, both aspects that are closely related to, and impact on, student learning. We know that a supportive environment is optimal. So what does our HUB offer?

- Emergency items such as: spare uniforms, lunches, stationery packs & breakfast club
- Positive Behaviour for Learning reward systems such as our whole school 'Pay Way' system
- Intervention and extension activities
- Attendance support including: 90% attendance celebrations, Indigenous Artie Attendance program, connecting families with agency support to assist with regular school attendance and engagement
- Lunch time activities on the veranda including our Moriarty soccer run on the oval during lunch breaks
- Chaplain services - students can hang out with
